

OUTBACK SAFARI #2

6 days - 10 April to 15 April 2025

Day 1 - 10 April

You will fly from Brisbane into Alice Springs. If you live outside of the Brisbane/Gold Coast/Sunshine Coast area we will book your flights from your nearest regional airport. Today we visit Alice Springs Desert Park and Zoo - make sure you see the bird show!

On the way to our campsite we stop at Anzac Hill overlooking Alice Springs and views out to the spectacular West MacDonnell Ranges. Your safari driver will demonstrate the tent set up and dismantle routine, watch carefully as you will be expected to do this with your own tent. Your HAP Supervisors will go through the safari rules, rosters and what to expect on tour.

Day 2 - 11 April

We leave Alice Springs and head to Kings Canyon. We will arrive at Kings Creek Station arriving late morning to set up camp. We take a short drive to Karrke Aboriginal Cultural Experience and Tours. The tour covers Aboriginal bush medicine use, plant and bird knowledge, Aboriginal dot painting weapon making (including spears and boomerangs), clapping stick making, bush tucker gathered seasonally and organic seeds used for jewellery making. Tonight, if the weather permits, we can enjoy marshmallows around the campfire and sleeping under the stars.

Day 3 - 12 April

Early rise this morning to explore Kings Canyon. The sheer walls of the canyon rise up 270 metres, making it the deepest gorge in Central Australia.

All students must have two litres of water to do the walk. If you have reasonable fitness you can walk to the rim of the Canyon which offers spectacular views over the 'Lost City' and 'Garden of Eden'.

Or you can walk the base of the Canyon and look up at the spectacular cliff faces. After this exhilarating walk we enjoy breakfast before continuing on to Yulara, arriving mid-afternoon. You can relax at camp, swim in the pool, or take a short scenic walk to see Uluru from a distance. Late afternoon we head out to view the amazing colours of sunset over Uluru.

Day 4 - 13 April

This morning we visit Uluru for a guided base walk to hear about the history of the rock and the Indigenous Australian people.

We respect their cultural beliefs that this is a sacred site. Time to visit the Cultural Centre and learn about the history of the local Mobs (tribes) and Clans, the Dreamtime and sacred ceremonies.

We return to camp for lunch before heading off to visit Kata Tjuta this afternoon - even larger and, some say, more brooding than Uluru!

Walk to the lookout and marvel at the imposing domes before returning to camp.

Day 5 - 14 April

After breakfast we head to Alice Springs for the last night of our Outback Adventure.

This evening we enjoy a private visit from the Reptile Centre and experience bearded dragons, frill neck lizards and large pythons up close and personal. A perfect opportunity for a few unique photos!

Day 6 - 15 April

This morning we visit the Royal Flying Doctors Service and School of the Air to learn about these important services in remote areas. Then it's time to say goodbye to the Red Centre. We hope you enjoyed your Outback Safari!
